We can look at nature in the same way that we look at a complicated machine, to see how all the parts fit together. Every living thing has its place in nature, and ecology is the study of how things live in relation to their surroundings. It is a relatively new science and is of great importance today. It helps us understand how plants and animals depend on each other and their surroundings in order to survive. Ecology also helps us work toward saving animals and plants from extinction and solving the problems caused by pollution. Plants and animals can be divided into two groups, depending on their ecological function. Plants capture the sun's light energy and use it to produce new growth, so they are called producers; animals consume plants and other animals, so they are called consumers. All the plants and animals that live in one area and feed off each other make up a community. The relationship between the plants and animals in a community is called a food web; energy passes through the community via these food webs.
